Repository-based or “Green” open access

- Open repository
- Free to publish
 - Free to read
 - Preprint
- Author accepted manuscript

Journal-based or “Gold” Open Access

- Pay to publish in a fully OA journal
 - Free to read
- Publisher journals

“Diamond” Open access

- Free to read
- Free to publish
- Community driven journals
- Institutionally supported journals

“Hybrid” open access

- Pay article processing charge to publish article as OA
 - Article is made free to read
 - Other articles in that journal requires a paid subscription to access


